

Policy and Declaration of Compliance To California Proposition 65

Sentran Corporation is registered in the State of Oregon and with over 25 years experience manufacturing safe electrical current and voltage sensors, is fully aware of our environmental responsibility.

California Proposition 65, is officially known as the Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986. As required by Proposition 65, Sentran Corporation will provide warnings to other businesses and the people of California about significant exposures to chemicals that are known to cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. Sentran Corporation has reviewed the warnings found on www.P65Warnings.ca.gov, amendments adopted on August 31, 2016 by the State of California Office of Environment Health Hazard Assessment (OEHHA) to Article 6 and the Clear and Reasonable Warnings for California Proposition 65 which became effective on August 30, 2018.

There are traces of some chemicals inherent within the materials on the list that are necessary to make dry electrical transformers and sensors and are listed in the warnings provided with each shipment. Nickel alloy and plastic for example. We do not use solder containing lead. Sentran Corporation regrinds and reuses all plastic, recycles all copper, nickel and steel material. We have in-house procedures to monitor and track all chemicals and provide detailed information to anyone that has the need to know.

Just because Sentran Corporation provides written warnings with all products shipped to customers, it does not mean our transformer products cause cancer or reproductive harm. Our products have been tested by Underwriters Laboratories and meet or exceed US and international standards for safety and compatibility to the application for which they are intended.
